## General Membership Meeting

*Tuesday, September 22, 2020 | 6:00pm | Zoom video conference*

### Call to Order/Approval of Minutes

---

- Note: This meeting was held via Zoom video conference due to the COVID-19/coronavirus pandemic. There were approximately 42 participants in the conference which included band booster officers, directors along with students and band family members.
- President Ida Musgrove called the meeting to order at 6:07pm.
- Review and approval of prior general membership meeting minutes was done electronically by Shelly Allen, Danielle Belden and Sheryl Powell. - Band Booster Treasurer Mattia Mackenroth provided the treasurer's report and current balance is \$39,526.60. Contact Mattia directly with any questions regarding financial updates.

### Discussion/Committee Reports

- **Jaguar Jog 5k/10k:** Event was held on Saturday, September 19th with approximately 225 participants. The In-Person event held many challenges this year and thanks to the committee was a great success. Final financial results will be determined and communicated in the next month. Thanks to the Jaguar Jog committee for their dedication.
- **Football Programs:** Football program ads are currently still for sale and will remain so throughout the entire season, being added to the next available program after purchase/completion. First home game on 10/1 with the cut-off for orders was 9/17.
- **Spirit Gear:** 2 new designs on 3 shirt options is now available via our website at [www.johnsonbands.com](http://www.johnsonbands.com). Some are in stock and additional orders will be placed. We are planning a spirit gear pick up each Monday evening at the conclusion of evening rehearsals. The committee is also working on Band Specific JB branded items to be introduced soon via our website.
- **Game Day Meal Plans:** Game day meal plans are still available for purchase on our website through this coming Thursday. This will be shared via social media. Please remember that students will not be able to leave campus to pick up a meal on game days and parents are not allowed to bring/deliver food to campus due to COVID regulations this year. Students not participating in the meal plan will need to bring their dinner meal with them to school upon their arrival to campus.
- **Sponsorship:** Melissa Frensley provided our sponsorship update sharing that thus far the boosters have secured commitments on \$17,400. Also highlighted is this year's "Friends & Family" option where families can add a band students name and graduation year to the back of the band trailer for \$200 (\$100 for each additional sibling name added at the same time). These names will remain

indefinitely for multiple years (until the trailer is rewrapped or space runs out). Please help with sharing sponsorship opportunities.

- **Membership:** Current membership includes 22 Individual Members and 21 Family Memberships. Though all families are band boosters, regardless of membership status, we hope to increase our participation in this program to provide additional support of the band program. Memberships allow families or individuals to have a voice in the direction of the organization along with the ability to vote in general membership meetings. ## Directors Report – Mr. Joey Lucita

---

- **Band Rehearsal and Football Game Protocols:** Mr. Lucita reviewed items that every new band parent should know regarding evening rehearsals and game day protocols. Please remember that every time your student is on campus for a rehearsal or event the Daily COVID screening must be completed. (See [johnsonbands.com](http://johnsonbands.com), Info and Documents, Daily Covid Screening). Information on how band families purchase tickets to football games etc was reviewed and will be sent out via email. Attire was reviewed as well. Students will wear khaki shorts and a new gold shirt (which will be in prior to game day) as our band uniform with tennis shoes and short black socks. When cooler weather arrives, denim jeans will be worn (dark or medium wash with no holes, etc) . “Game hair” will be done (hair out of face, etc for both boys and girls) and no jewelry or makeup will be allowed (excluding color guard makeup as determined by directors).
- **Spring 2022 Trip:** Details and overview of the “Big” Band Trip to Hawaii over spring break 2022 was reviewed including approximate costs and itinerary. This trip is entirely optional and both families and students are invited to attend. Sign ups will begin in January 2021 with a monthly payment plan available. This trip will be available for current 8th grade students continuing in band in High School. Trip deposit of \$100 is planned to be due to January 6th, 2021 with total trip cost due on February 6, 2022 and monthly payments accepted. All payments are handled directly with the Trip company (not the band). Total cost is expected to be \$2105 for quad occupancy rooms, \$2195 for triple occupancy rooms, \$2385 for double occupancy rooms and \$2955 for single occupancy rooms (per person).
