## **Minutes**



- The meeting was called to order by Ida Musgrove at 6:38pm.
- Prior minutes from our previous meeting were electronically approved and posted to our website.
  Approvers for this meeting minutes who volunteered were Conrad Fjetland, Joan Forsythe and JoBeth Kee-Rees.
- **Treasurer's report** presented by Meredith Riechmann. Beginning balance on 4/4/2023 was \$64,419.54 Income of \$12,933.78 and expenses of \$37,870.82. We have an ending balance of \$39,482.50.
- Ms. Patty Moreno, Fine Arts Director for Hays CISD was present to share an announcement. Mr. Duffy will not be returning to Johnson High School due to a personnel matter. Specific issues were not able to be disclosed and she was not taking any questions from the attendees. The vacant position will be posted on the Hays CISD website. For the remainder of the year, Mr. Malik to directing the Wind Symphony band and Mr. Vereen will lead the color guard. Both groups will continue to be part of the spring concert on Thursday. Dr. Michael Watson and Jason Adams from the District Fine Arts Department were also present in attendance.
- Mr. Lucita followed up the statement to address the membership regarding how this affects next years marching show. The directors have already begun making plans to fill the interim gap and have parties interested in working with the band on creative design. To support these efforts of hiring a creative director, the Group Fund fundraiser currently in progress will be extended for approximately 2 weeks. He has asked everyone to jump on and share/support the group fund to meet the new goals and support our kids.
- Ida Musgrove followed up with a message that our kids are resilient, versatile and have overcome every obstacle thrown their way. Color Guard persevered through Mr. Washington leaving in the middle to Winter Guard season and our kids will surprise us. Our message should simply be that everything is going to be fine and support a positive message to our kids. Next year is going to be GREAT and they do not need to worry about this.

### Old Business

- Sheryl Powell, VP Hospitality, informed the membership that the band boosters are hosting "Snack Day" for Teacher Appreciation week tomorrow May 10th. She thanked everyone for donating snacks in support of this event for the 238 teachers at JHS.
- Tina Cuellar, VP Events, reviewed the theme days for the Spring Training Camps that will be held next week. (See schedule above). Note that the grades denote what class each student will be in next fall (not current grade levels as current seniors do not attend). Snacks will be provided each day at the end of camp and SLT parents will be asked to assist where needed. \*\*NOTE: attendance at each camp is important as every student will be measured for fall uniforms/show tops to ensure they ordered early.
  - May 20th is parent registration day from 9-12. Please attend to ensure your child is fully registered for band, you are connected for email/communication/etc. We will also have stations to become a band booster, meet and connect with your sections/Parent Section Leads, and more.
  - May 20th Parent meeting from 12-1pm with a parent preview at 1pm.

### New Business

 Amber Reue, Spirit Gear Chair, reviewed the upcoming TMF store that will be opening on May 15-June 9th. This is the store to order your DUFFLE bags, family spirit gear (Mom, Dad, grandparent, sibling apparel). Orders will process/be manufactured upon the store closing and shipped directly to your home when fulfilled. Do not wait. You may also order



extra uniform pieces (Freshman receive 1 uniform kit but we highly recommend extras) and all returning band/guard students should order directly if you need new/additional sizes or items. \*\*\*NOTE: it is highly recommended to have multiple compression tops, practice tops and anything else we wear frequently in the fall so you aren't doing late night washing after football games, etc.

- Spirit Gear will be sold at spring camp on May 17th black and gold tees only to support kids for Jag day.
- Full in stock spirit gear will be sold on the May 20 registration day.
- Spirit gear committee meeting will also be on May 17th at 6:30pm. Join US!
- We are planning to offer a padded seat cushion with our Jaguar Elite sponsorship to sell at football games - this will be great for marching season stadiums as well. Be on lookout for this new item and the others that

- VP Support Michelle Florez
  - Uniform Donations being accepted: we will accept past season uniform donations of seniors or any student who outgrew their items. A bin/box will be in band hall for you/your student to donate these. They will be used for student sin need or if items were forgotten, etc next season.
  - Concert uniforms will be worn for the spring concert and must be cleaned/dry cleaned and returned by May 18th. Leave plastic wrapping on them when you return. If not returned, your student will not be able to exempt finals at JHS.
  - Reminder of uniform fittings being completed during spring camps.
- Guard Liaison Michelle Silva reviewed information for color guard and welcomed new families to the meeting.
  - Guard will go back to the color guard group me instead of the varsity/JV groups.
  - Guard should wear compression and tight fitting clothing for their fittings during spring camp.
  - Guard will visit middle schools on May 11th for recruiting visits.
- Treasurer Meredith Riechmann reviewed the proposed 2023-2024 booster budget that will be voted on this evening. No questions were raised. The budget was sent to Regular members for review several days prior to the meeting.
- Officer Elections: The candidates for board positions were called to the front to introduce themselves and share their previous volunteer experience with the boosters. All outgoing members of the board were thanked for their past service to the program.
- Karen Shelton conducted the vote, collected all ballots from Regular Members and, with volunteer Jana Owen, counted results.

### Directors Report

- Spring concert schedule was reviewed. This counts as their final and involves 3 parts:
  Warm Up, Performance and Audience. Students must remain for the entirety of the concert to watch other bands perform.
- Reminder of extension for Group Fund fundraiser.
- THe Italy trip will be postponed to 2025 to allow families longer for payment plans as we have had many requests for this since many families travel together or have multiple



students in the program. The band will also use Italy as a theme for music selection that year to enhance the educational experience.

- There will be a small spring break trip for 2024 (next year) that is yet to be determined. Possible trips mentioned include Dallas or New Orleans.
- Students in Wind Ensemble and Wind Symphony will perform at graduation. Senior band students should arrange for a friend to bring their instrument to graduation to play the final school song.
- Attend the May 20th parent meeting to hear all about summer band.

#### Announcements

- Karen Shelton revealed that the budget passed and all candidates were elected with 45 total votes being cast.
- Meeting was adjourned at 7:54pm. All newly elected board members to remain briefly afterwards.
